

Common Questions and Answers

As the duty officer expect to field a few questions as well as issuing equipment to members. Here is some additional information to help with the frequently asked questions

Q. How do I join?

A. Visit the website and down load a form, there may be a number of forms in a corner of the club. Try and resist just pointing them at the membership secretary.

Q. Can I do a course?

A. The waiting list is usually long so in the meantime join in with the novice sessions every Wednesday and pick it up gradually.

Q. Can I just do a taster session?

A. Unfortunately you are only insured if you're a member. A refund could be arranged if you don't like it.

Q. What boats are suitable?

A. Consult the boat guide folder on the counter in the club. Private boats are marked with owners name (usually a name tag on the end toggle) all other boats are club boats freely available.

Q. How to fit a buoyancy aid

A. A buoyancy aid should be tight enough below the ribcage not to simply slip over the head in the water.

Q. What's going on tonight?

A. A blackboard with paddle venues and times is in place on the club doors. Long paddle, Medium paddle, Novice paddle.
